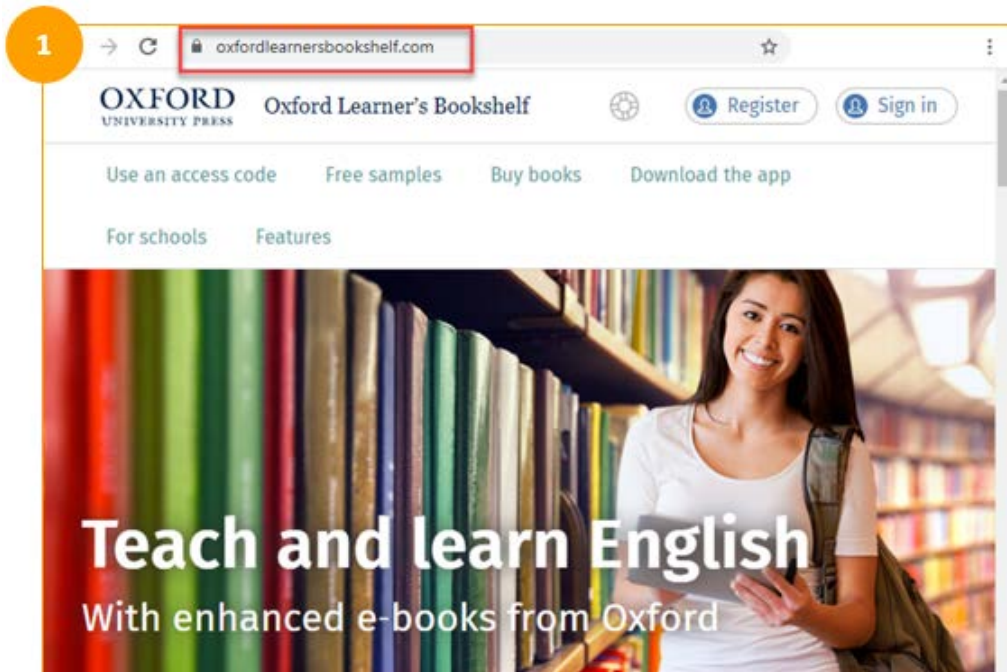


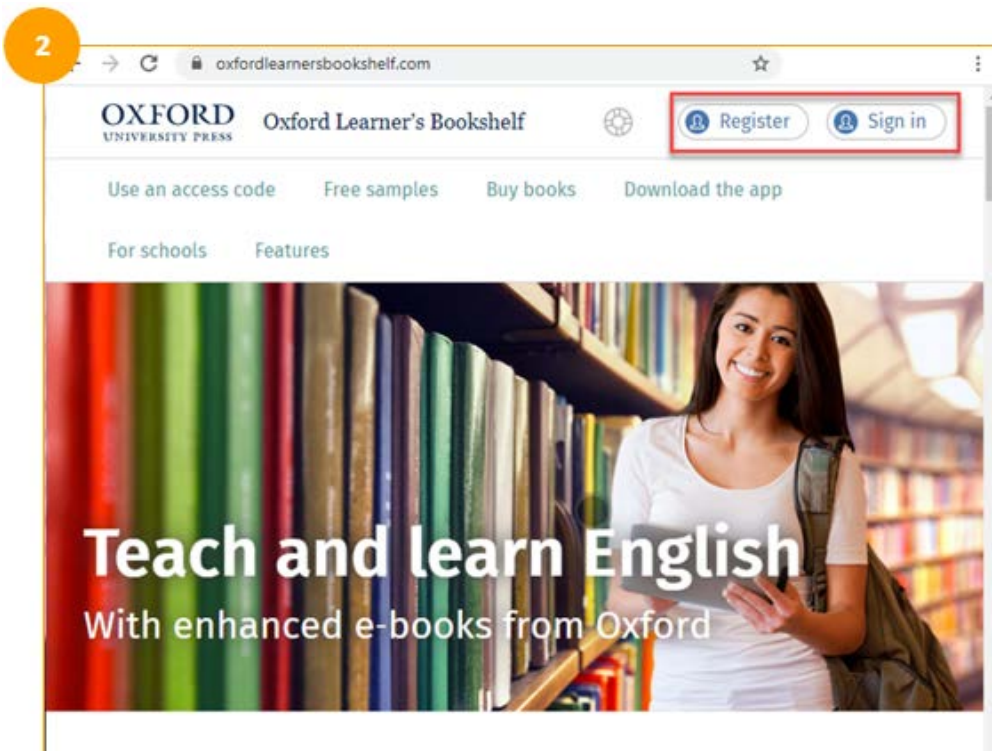
How to use your access code

Register for an Oxford ID or **'Sign in'** if you already have one.

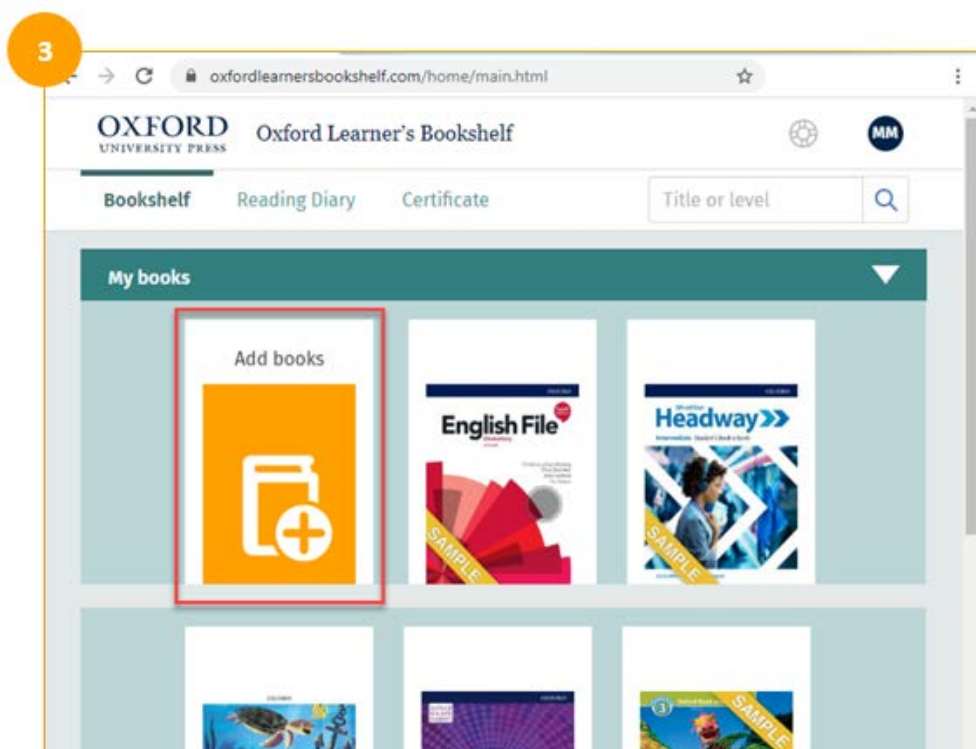

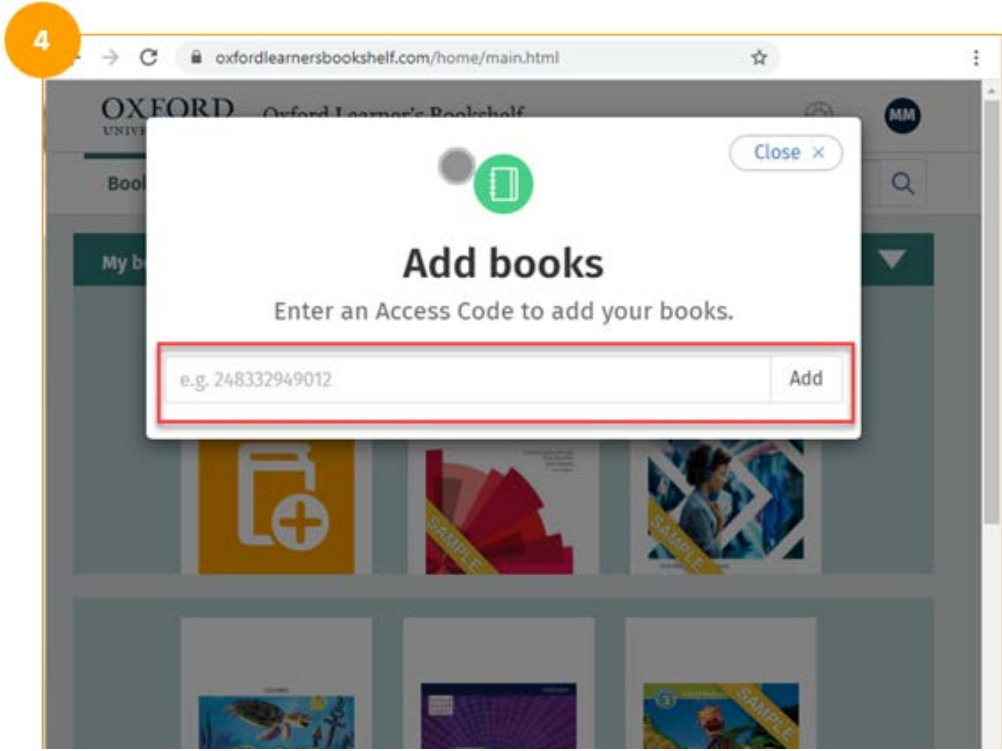

To use your Access Code, choose the **'Add books'** button.



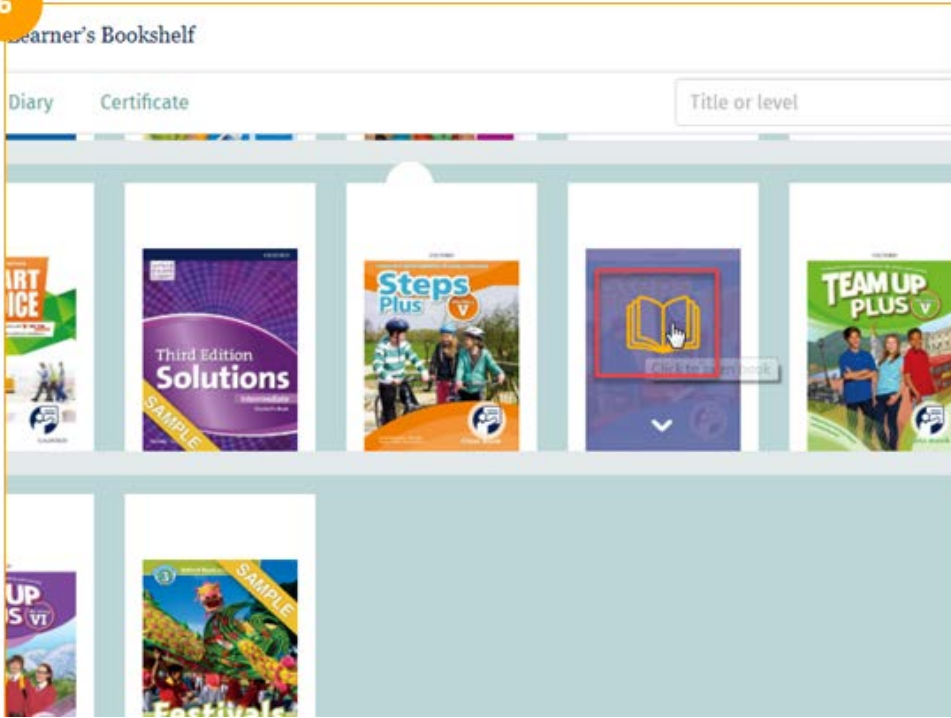
Put your Access Code in the box.

Important! You only need to use the code once.



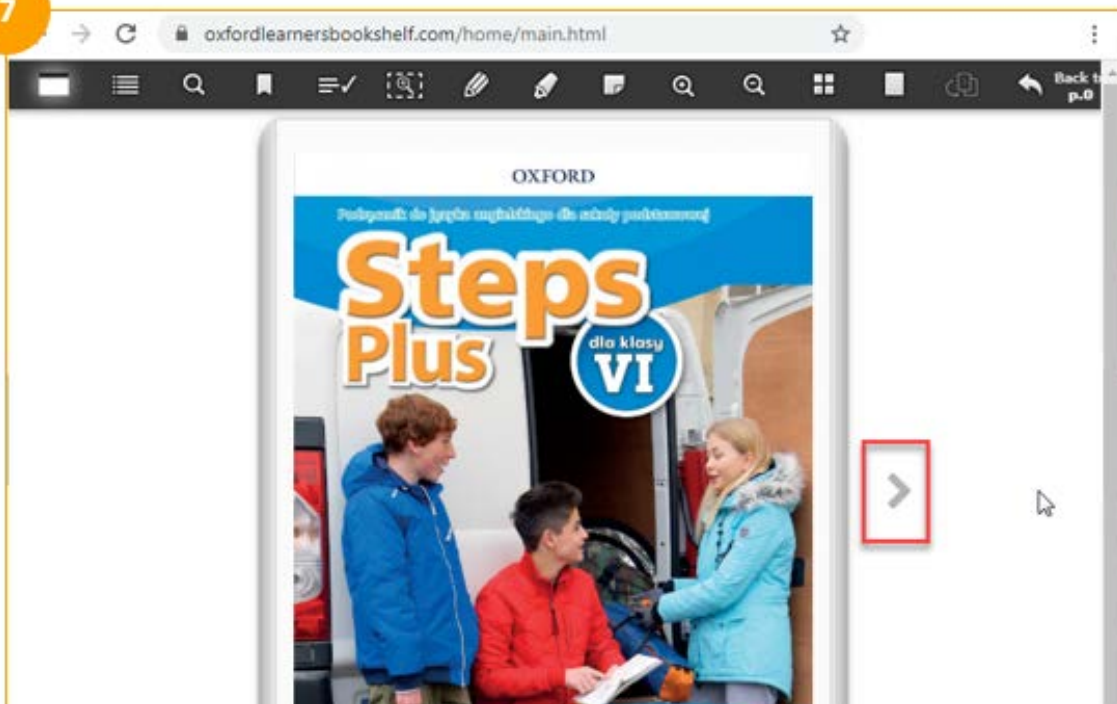
Your book is now on your bookshelf. The books are ordered by title.

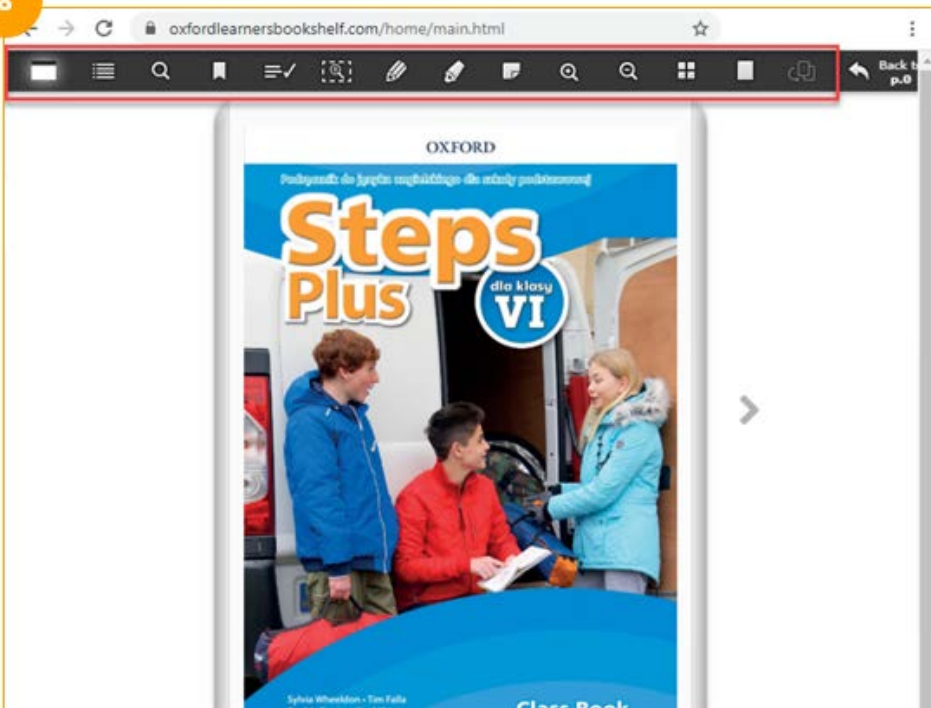
To open the book, click on its cover.

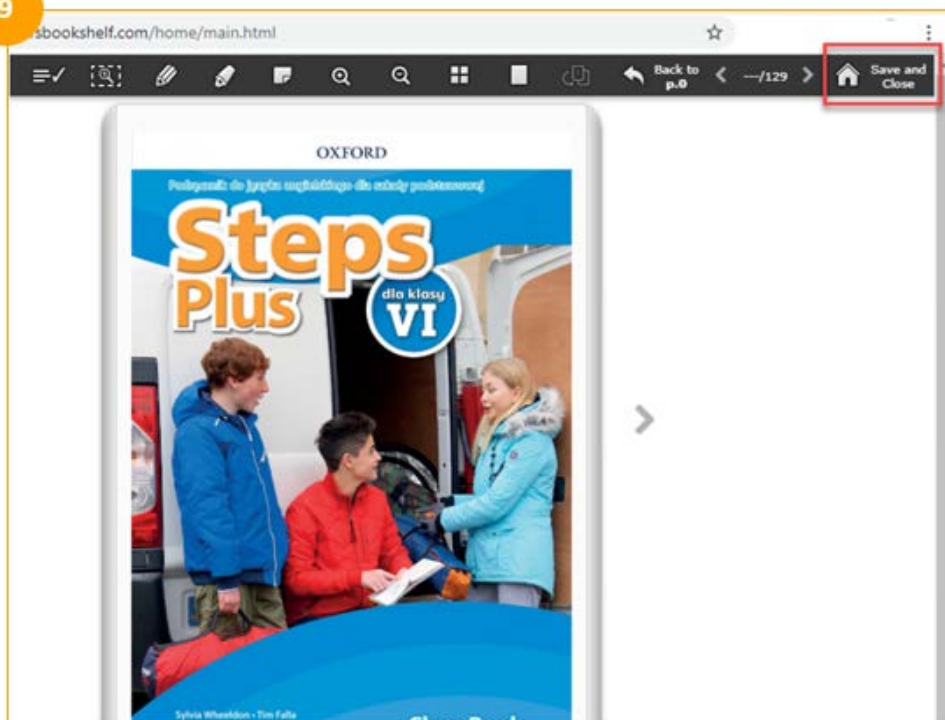
When the book opens, use arrows to turn the pages.

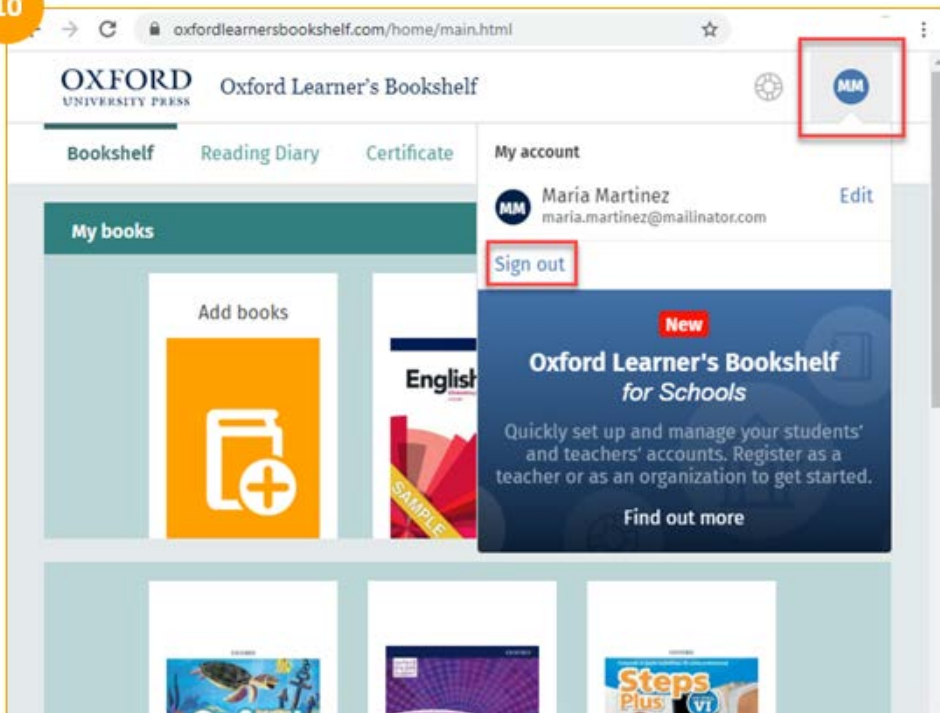


Explore the toolbar to search, add notes and much more.

Download e-books to a computer or device

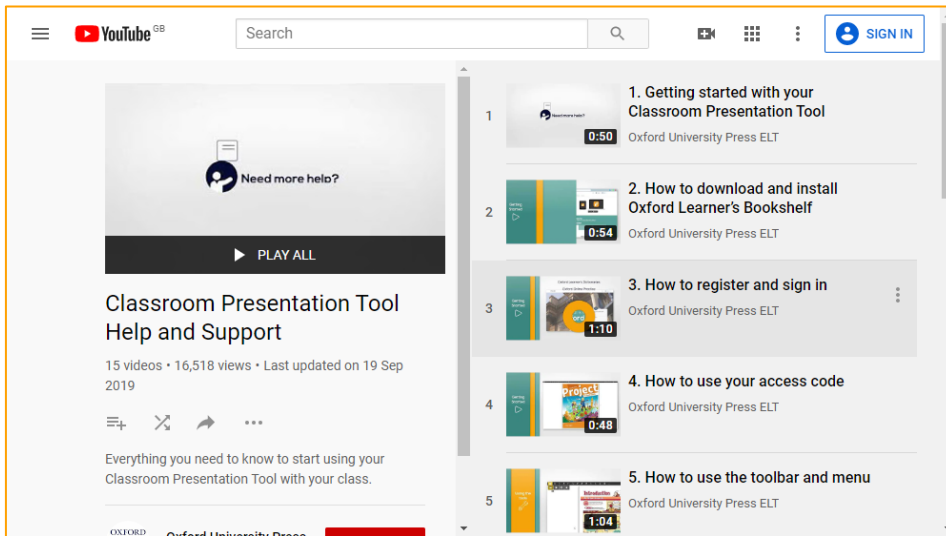

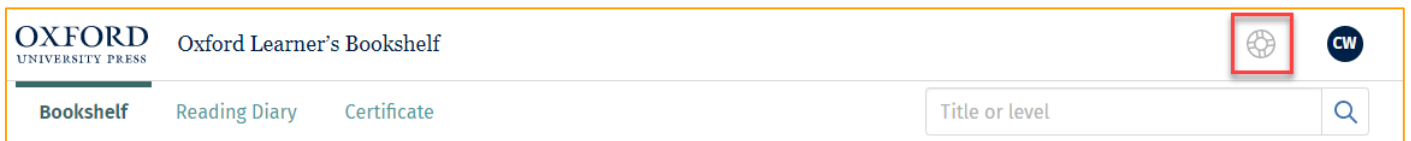
