

There is **some water** in the glass. (V kozarcu je nekaj vode. – Ni je mogoče prešteti.) There are **two bottles of water.** (Štejemo steklenice in NE vode.)

Zanimivost: nekateri samostalniki so lahko oboje, števni in neštevni.

I like coffee. I have two coffees a day. (Rad imam kavo. Popijem dve kavi = dve skodelici kave na dan.)




